What is Assistive Technology?

Assistive Technology is any device which enables an individual with disabilities to perform a task that would otherwise be difficult, painful, or impossible.

Assistive Technology can be:

No Tech: Raised dots used to identify objects by touch.

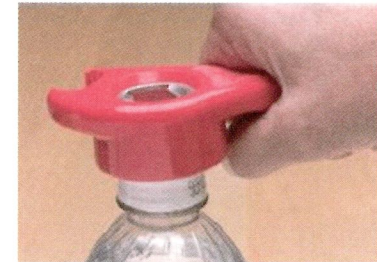
Low Tech: A vibrating wrist watch for the deaf or hard of hearing.

Or High Tech: computer software that recognizes speech and turns it into text.
